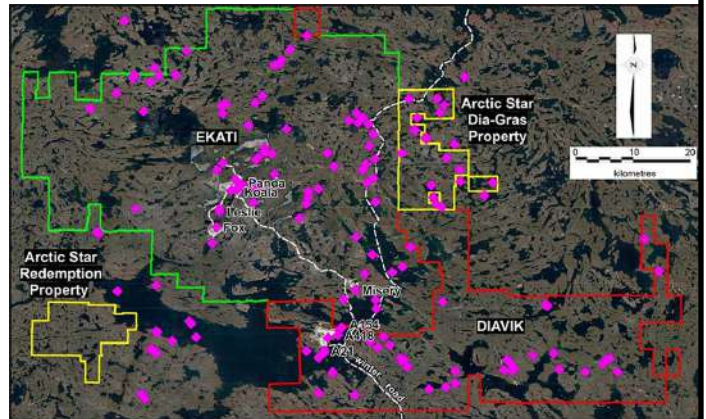
## Diagras Diamond Property, N.W.T

Buddy Doyle, Arctic Stars' VP of Exploration lead the team that discovered the Diavik Diamond Mine.

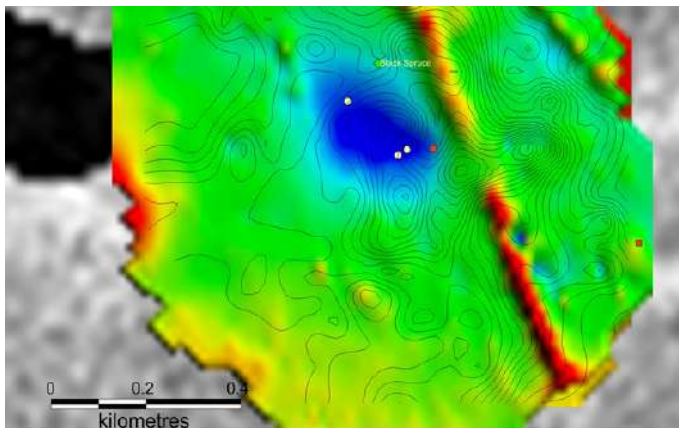
### Diagras Claims & Kimberlites

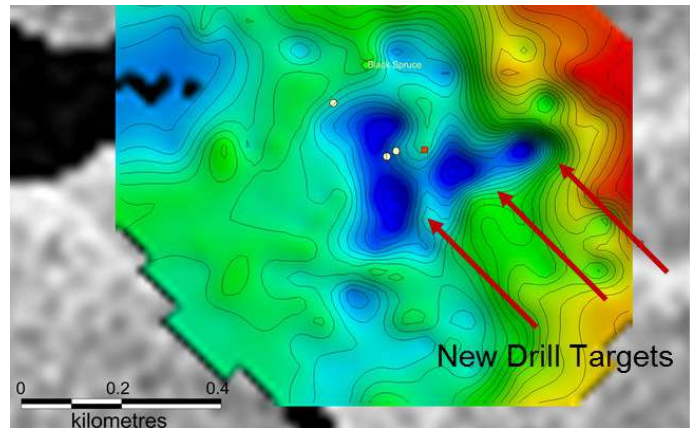
## Black Spruce Kimberlite

Gravity technology shows rock that is less dense such as kimberlites than the surrounding country rock such as granite.

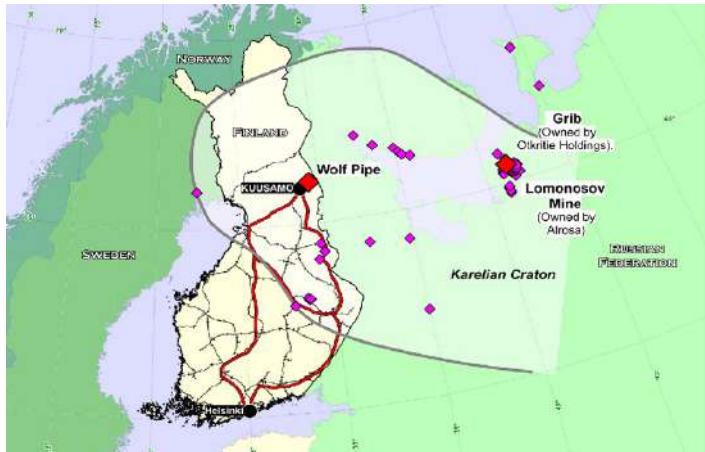

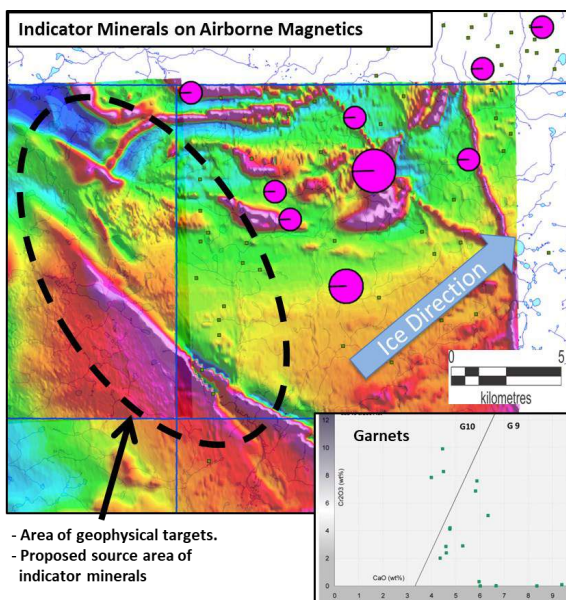
